SUBJECT	Critical Care and Paramedic Standing Orders

PURPOSE

To clarify Standing Orders for the Critical Care EMT in the Midstate Region

BACKGROUND

With the adoption of the NYS collaborative protocols adopted in 2017, the Midstate REMAC is seeking to simplify the use of these protocols and maintain current patient care standards in the Midstate Region.

LIMITATIONS

This advisory is for Midstate Region Critical Care and Paramedic providers only

EXPECTATIONS

Midstate Region Critical Care providers will have standing orders for medications corresponding to Paramedic standing orders, age specific. Additionally, both levels will have standing orders for <u>Sodium Bicarbonate</u>, <u>Calcium Chloride</u> and <u>Dexamethasone</u>.

<u>Epinephrine Drips</u> and <u>Nebulized Epinephrine</u> will require medical control for AEMT-CC.

Pediatric IV medication administrations are paramedic only in non-arrest situations.

Ketamine is a Paramedic Only drug
