EMS Provider Suspensions

Mid-State EMS Procedure Guidelines for the Provider Suspended by the Agency Medical Director

Purpose:

To ensure Midstate Providers care is consistent with Midstate Standards

Definitions:

Agency Medical Directors have the responsibility and the authority to limit or prevent a Provider from practicing in the field. If an Agency Medical Director sanctions or suspends a Provider for a care issue, they will notify the REMAC in writing through the Clinical Coordinator of their decision with an explanation of the cause.

Procedure:

Upon receipt of a sanction or suspension the Clinical Coordinator, Regional Medical Director and at least one other REMAC Physician will review the issue with the Provider. If, upon review the committee feels the issue warrants regional suspension or sanction the Provider will be notified of their decision.
