Policy Statement #18-01 Adopted 3/20/18 Re: BLS/AEMT 12 lead acquisition and transmission program

Midstate EMS Agencies wishing to implement a BLS/AEMT 12 lead acquisition and transmission program must:

- 1. Make written request to the Midstate REMAC including the endorsement of the Agency Medical Director
- 2. Provide the REMAC with policies, training plan and quality assurance policies
- 3. Maintain competencies and education documentation for authorized providers
- 4. Description of 12 lead device to be utilized by BLS/AEMT personnel
- 5. Copy of *Medical Director Verification Form (DOH 4362)* indicating approval to participate in the 12-lead acquisition program.

The EMS Program Agency will submit the application and supporting documents to the REMAC at the next scheduled meeting:

- 1. Provide the EMS Agency with the Midstate REMAC approval letter.
- 2. Provide the EMS Agency with BLS/AEMT 12 lead hospital agreement.
- 3. Maintain copies of all Agency documentation in the Midstate EMS Agency file.
