Re: Syringe Epinephrine for Basic EMT's

Midstate EMS Agencies wishing to implement a BLS Syringe Epinephrine program must:

- 1. Make a written request to the Midstate REMAC that includes a signed endorsement of the agency Medical Director.
- 2. Provide the REMAC with policies, training plan and quality assurance policies.
- 3. Maintain competencies and education documentation for authorized providers.
- 4. Submit a copy of the *Medical Director Verification* form (DOH-4362) indicating approval to participate in the syringe epinephrine program.
- 5. Follow the all requirements of NYS DOH Policy #17-06

The EMS Program Agency will:

- 1. Submit the application and the following supporting documents to the REMAC at the next scheduled meeting:
- 2. Provide the EMS agency with the Midstate approval letter
- 3. Provide the EMS agency with BLS Syringe Epinephrine agreement
- 4. Maintain copies of all agency documentation in the Midstate EMS agency file.
